Pictou County Salmon Rivers

Salmon enter all the rivers in Pictou County. These rivers include Barney's, French, Sutherland's, East, Middle, West, River John, Caribou and Toney Rivers. All of these rivers are considered fall run rivers; that is, salmon do not enter these rivers in spring or summer. It is only in the fall, usually late September or October, when there is sufficient water that salmon enter the rivers to spawn. Prime fishing time usually the last two weeks of October.

The rivers are considered small rivers and as a result, long rods and long casts are not necessary. An 8.5 to 9 foot rod with a #8 line is ideal. Big, flashy flies such as Mickey Finn and Butterflies are very effective. Dry fly fish can be very challenging at this time of the year.

The ratio of salmon to grilse varies from river to river but there is a greater number of larger fish in all the rivers. All fish over 63 centimeters (24.8 inches) must be released. The season for salmon runs Sept. 1 to Oct. 31.

The rivers are easily wadeable and felt bottomed waders are recommended. All of the major pools on the three larger rivers (East, Middle and West) are easily accessible by car and / or a short walk.


