The St. Mary's River is a world-class Atlantic salmon stream in Atlantic Canada. Located in eastern Nova Scotia, the river has always played a central role in the lives of our residents, beginning with the aboriginal people.

Historic Sherbrooke Village is located at the head of the tide on the river. This restored village shows visitors how our settlers lived in the mid to late 1800s.

The St. Mary's River Association's vision is "Health for the river, the Atlantic salmon, and the community."

The Association was formed in 1979 and operates an Education and Interpretive Center in Sherbrooke, Nova Scotia.
